Standard shocks must have standard 12.7mm (1/2") diameter bushings and maximum 12.70mm eyelet width

Due to the numerous available shocks, please carefully check for sufficient clearance between tires, shock and frame parts in any position throughout the complete shock stroke, especially when bottoming out - frame or shocks parts must not collide in any position!

* 190x45 will keep original geometry but slightly decrease rear wheel travel.

** 210x50 will keep original geometry but slightly decrease rear wheel travel.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Original Epic Shocks have a very small air can diameter!

2018-2020 models:

Many of the commonly available aftermarket shocks may not fit every frame size For small and medium frame sizes we recommend X-Fusion Microlite or Rock Shox SIDLuxe.

2021-2023 models:

Clearance is not as critical as with 2018-2013 models, but large air cans may still not fit every frame size. Rock Shox SIDLuxe has confirmed fit for all frame sizes.
